Library Receives Donation of Marion Coughlin Paintings

In September, the Library was the recipient of a donation of **20 Marion Coughlin paintings!** This generous gift was presented to the Library by former Olean residents, Dr. Carol Royer of Mabank, TX, and Mr. Dave Royer of La Pine, OR.



Dr. Royer contacted the Library in July, asking about our potential interest in the donation. We explained that we were in possession of a small number of her paintings, which were collected by the Library's former arts curator, Robert Taylor, who retired in 2016.

Royer shared her family's connection to Coughlin, saying that her mother, Edna Royer, had no living relatives by the age of 12, and wound up living with the Coughlin family in Olean while she attended high school. Marion and Edna became close friends, and Marion eventually willed her painting collection to Edna.

The Royer children, Carol and Dave, inherited the collection from their mother, and felt it would be in good hands at the Library, where the whole community could enjoy it.

Exhibits of her work were held in the Gallery in both 2012 and 2017, and both were extremely well received by the community. However, because the Library only had a small number of her paintings, community members were asked to loan items from their personal collections to help fill out the exhibits. Therefore, we were very excited about the possibility of a donation of a large number of paintings.

Royer visited the area in September and brought the paintings to the Library during her stay. They are an impressive collection of work. An exhibit of this collection will take place in the Library's Art Gallery throughout the month of November, beginning Wednesday, November 2nd.



Dan, an alumnus of St. Bonaventure University and founder of Mt. Irenaeus, invites others on an ancient journey, seen through the eyes of a contemporary pilgrim, in his first book,



Franciscan Lectio: Reading the World through the Living Word.

Franciscan Lectio, which the author describes as an "interpretive book", is for all those who are on a spiritual journey who long to see the world more beautifully and deeply and to become more attentive and present. It is divided into four parts following a model St. Clare offers: Gaze, Consider, Contemplate, and Imitate, all of which invite readers to explore with their own imagination.


